

Considering Switching your Electric or Gas Supplier?

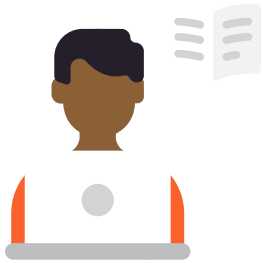
What you Need to know about Shopping for Electric and Natural Gas Companies

1. Do your research



We recommend visiting papowerswitch.com and pagasswitch.com. Both are official state hosted and monitored websites. All suppliers listed on this site are licensed to provide service in Pennsylvania.

2. Understand terms and conditions



Offers can have different terms and conditions. Ask for a contract summary and disclosure statement. Review this carefully to ensure your understanding matches before signing up for service.

3. Calendar the end of your contract



Although suppliers are required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's regulations to notify customers of the end of their contracts, it is best to keep track of this information to ensure the account is not rolled into a variable or higher rate when the contract expires.

4. Watch your account



Be sure to monitor your monthly electric and natural gas bills to ensure you are being charged the agreed upon rate with your selected supplier.
